THE DAYCARE AT CCS

Yes, it's true. The board has approved the expansion of our Preschool to include a full time daycare. The daycare is slated to open on August 4, 2008. The only change to our current offering is that we will be able to accommodate parents who need full time care for their children. The enrollment fee is \$25 and the Day Care cost will be \$20/student/day. Parents who don't need full-day care will still be able to enroll their children in our Preschool, Prekindergarten or Kindergarten programs for a

half day.

BOARD APPROVES 2008-2009 FEES

At its annual budget meeting, the CCS School Board unanimously approved the fee schedule and preliminary budget for the 2008-2009 school year. The top priority was increasing teacher salaries. Accordingly, an average salary increase for the teachers of nearly 6% was approved. A 6% tuition increase will be used to offset this additional expense. No increase was made to registration fees. Registration for the 2008-2009 school year will begin in April.

RESULTS OF THE EXPLORE TESTS

Our 8th graders along with 200+ 8th graders from Gering public schools took the Explore Test (pre-ACT) last fall. One of our students had the highest overall score and 2 other CCS students placed 2nd to the highest.
