I have been to many Early Childhood conferences and the ACSI Early Childhood Conference that I attended in Feb. was the best mainly because of the Christ-centered content with all the presenters. The opening with worship songs and prayer was just the beginning. To meet with other believers who have a passion for early childhood education was by far the best way to enhance the early childhood experience for directors, teachers, and those who work with young children.

I attended the directors' track which included three sessions; 1) Discover the ACSI Virtual University, 2) Quality improvements to You Program, and 3) Leadership and Personal Growth. In the first session I learned about the virtual university training to provide a Preschool Education Certificate to any staff. This would help the school in its accreditation.
