Fundraising Fees

Similar to most private schools, the true cost of educating a student is not covered by tuition alone. This discrepancy is often called “the gap.” Each year CCS relies on fundraising to fill this gap. Our primary fundraisers are Clean City Scramble and Enchilada Factory. We have other fundraisers, but participation in these two fundraisers is REQUIRED for Every family Kindergarten—5th grade. It is imperative that each family participate EACH semester so that we can reach our fundraising goals. Please note that if every family only does the minimum we will not reach our goals. Please consider going above and beyond these requirements. **If you do not meet the requirement, the difference MUST be added into your family’s fundraiser packet.**

If you choose to not participate, you can pay the minimum requirement each semester to cover the Fundraising Fee. If you choose this option, the fee MUST be paid by the fundraiser deadline or turned in with the fundraiser packet.

PERMISSION/WAIVER FORM

Functions and Activities: It is my understanding that participating in the programs and recreational and other activities is a privilege. Release of Liability : By signing this Permission/Waiver Form, I expressly warrant that my child(ren) registered at CCS is capable of withstanding both the physical and mental demands of the activities discussed above. I also expressly assume all risks of the child participating in the activities, whether such risks are known or unknown to me at this time. I further release this organization and its leaders, employees, volunteers, and agents from any claim that my child(ren) may have or that I may have against them as a result of injury or illness incurred during the course of participation in the activities. This release of liability shall include (without limitation) any claims of negligence or breach of warranty. This release of liability is also intended to cover all claims that members of the child(ren)'s or my family or estate, heirs, representatives, or assigns may have against this organization or its leaders, employees, volunteers, or agents. I further agree to indemnify and hold harmless this organization and its leaders, employees, volunteers, or agents from any and all claims arising from my participation in its activities and programs, or as a result of injury or illness of my child during such activities.

First Aid and Emergency Medical Treatment: I recognize that there may be occasions where the child(ren) named above may be in need of first aid or emergency medical treatment as a result of an accident, illness, or other health condition or injury. I do hereby give permission for agents of this organization to seek and secure any needed medical attention or treatment for the child named above including hospitalization, if in the agent's opinion such need arises. In doing so I agree to pay all fees and costs arising from this action to obtain medical treatment. I give permission for attending physician(s) and other medical personnel to administer any needed medical treatment, including surgery and, again, I agree to pay for the medical treatment. I give permission to transport the child(ren) enrolled at CCS to a medical treatment center in a non-emergency vehicle in a medical emergency situation.

PARENTAL COVENANT

2022 - 2023

1. We have considered the school's purpose, statement of faith, curriculum, discipline, dress code, methods, testing, counseling and motives of the school, and have agreed to make them our choice for the coming school year.
2. We accept the challenge to "train up a child in the way he should go" (Proverbs 22:6) and place our trust in Community Christian School to extend that training and discipline more completely, upholding and supporting the high academic standards of the school by providing a place at home for our child(ren) to study.
3. Although children of many Christian denominations make up the student body at CCS, each student (and parent) enters with the awareness that all teaching will be based upon the CCS Statement of Faith. We pledge our fullest cooperation to keep doctrinal controversy and denominationalism out of the school at all times.
4. We pledge loyal support to the school through prayer, positive attitude, attendance at meetings, and faithful and regular tuition payments. Complaints or negative comments will be shared **ONLY** with the teacher, administrator, or person involved and not with my child(ren) or other people, following the Matthew 18 principle.
5. We agree to pay tuition according to the schedule or other arrangements made. We understand that if our account is 60 days past due, and no arrangements have been made, our child will no longer be able to attend CCS. If circumstances beyond my control force me to withdraw my child(ren), I understand that the current month's tuition is due in full. Prorated tuition will be reimbursed if necessary.
6. We give permission to the teachers and administration to make and enforce school policies in a manner consistent with Christian principles. We are aware that we may be responsible to cover damages to school property, including breakage or damage to windows, abuse of books or any personal property of CCS, the staff, or students of this school.
7. We understand that CCS is not staffed to provide services to students with specialized needs or students with significant behavioral issues. I understand that CCS will work with local providers when necessary. All academic/behavioral records and information must be presented to the school before enrollment is finalized. If information that affects the classroom learning environment is withheld from the school, the school has the right to un-enroll our child(ren).
8. We pledge that if, for any reason, our child(ren) does not respond favorably to the school, we will do everything in our power to cooperate with the school to help our child(ren) make the necessary adjustments. If these adjustments cannot be made then we agree to withdraw our child(ren).
9. We understand that only approximately 60% of our budget is met through tuition. We pledge to meet the family fundraising goal of \$350 **profit** EACH semester. We understand that payment is due when sales folders are due. *See Fundraising Fee sheet found in Registration Packet.*
10. We understand that if at any time the school determines, in its sole discretion, that our actions do not support the ministry, or reflect a lack of cooperation and commitment to the home and school working together, the school has the right to request withdrawal of our child(ren).

Welcome to CCS! We are excited to have your child here.

These are the special requirements for students entering school.

All Kindergarten requirements are applicable to new elementary students entering from out of state.

AGE REQUIREMENTS

Preschool: Child must be 3 years old BEFORE July 31.

Prekindergarten: Child must be 4 years old BEFORE July 31.

Kindergarten: Child must turn 5 years old BEFORE July 31.

Child must start Kindergarten if they turn 6 in 2022.

DOCUMENT REQUIREMENTS 2022 - 2023

The State of Nebraska and CCS Board of Education requires the following documentation to be presented before your child may START school:

PRESCHOOL, PREKINDER, & KINDERGARTEN

- **Certified Birth Certificate** – Bring the official birth certificate with the raised seal to the office and a copy will be made. This should be brought into the office as soon as possible. If you need to obtain a legal copy of a Nebraska Birth Certificate: <https://www.nebraska.gov/hhs/birthcert/birthapp.php>
- **Immunization Record** – Copy of Up-to-Date Immunization Records. Parents can print off these records by going to <https://dhhs.ne.gov/Pages/Immunization-Records.aspx> & clicking on the link to NESIIS. If you are in need of any refusal forms please go to <https://dhhs.ne.gov/Pages/School-Immunization.aspx> and look under exemptions.

KINDERGARTEN ADDITIONALLY NEEDS

- **Physical Examination** – Physicals must be performed between March 1 & August 28, 2022.
- **Vision Evaluation** – Vision evaluations must be performed between March 1 & August 28, 2022.
